TUNE (Traditional Music Undergraduate Network in Europe, 2021-2024) Joint Module

The introductory meeting of the Joint Module organized in the framework of TUNE project was conducted on Thursday 17 of March 2022 through a special digital platform. Professors and students from all partner institutions met online for the first time in order to discuss the goals and structure of the Module.

Through the Joint Module and all the other activities offered (the first outcomes of which will be presented during the “intensive week” in Arta between 30 of May and 3 of June 2022), the students get to know the music traditions of the other countries involved in the TUNE project. The cooperative spirit is cultivated, while the educative process is upgraded, the ultimate goal being the foundation of a viable network between the academic organizations involved in the project and in the long term the undergraduate students of traditional music.

The second meeting of the Joint Module is scheduled for Friday, the 25th of March 2022, at 11:00.
