

TRADITIONAL MUSIC UNDERGRADUATE NETWORK IN EUROPE

The "Intensive Week" (IW)

is one of the central components of the TUNE project, among the online platform and the joint module "Traditional Music Beyond Borders". More specifically, during the 1st IW at the Department of Music Studie's of the University of Ioannina (Arta campus), students and teachers from the project's member countries will have the opportunity to participate in workshops, lectures, ensemble work and some side activities.

The daily program includes three sections. During the first section each member country (Norway, Estonia, France, Spain) will present its traditional music in an hourly workshop. Greek music idioms will be presented in a second hourly workshop, including music idioms from Epirus, mainland Greece, prewar urban tradition and rebetiko, Greek islands, Pontos and Crete, Constantinople, Smyrna and Asia Minor. The workshops are organized by students, under their teachers' supervision.

During the second section the students from the five partner countries take part in rehearsals on a common repertoire that will be performed at the **final concert the last day of the IW (Friday 3/6)**.

During the third section, entitled "Creative time", the students will take part in creative interchanges, without any given framework. It is an opportunity for both students and teachers to select the participants for the final concert and shape the subject matter of each team.

The 1st Intensive Week of the project TUNE ends with a concert at the Castle of Arta. 38 students from the five Departments of Music Studies that work for the Tunes project prepare the concert repertoire during the Intensive Week. Tunes and songs from Estonia, France, Norway, Spain and Greece will be performed, while at the same time, the students will engage in understanding other musical languages, as well as the pluralism of personal musical expression. It's an interesting artistic endeavor for the creation of a common musical discourse, from promising artists.


